CEO'S MESSAGE

Happy Spring! This beautiful time of year is often buzzing with activity for Cape Fox Corporation (CFC). A new tourism season is underway for our commercial business, the federal business is submitting proposals and winning awards, and our corporate organization is planning upcoming events and celebrations.

For CFC, 2023 is a special year in that we are celebrating our 50th anniversary. This is a milestone “diamond” anniversary. This will mean that in 2023 we reflect on past triumphs and lessons, revel in our present stability, and forecast a future of growth and prosperity as we seek to position the company for greater growth and success for decades to come.

As we review the events of the first quarter of the year, I am delighted to see that we already saw the business blooming for 2023. I was encouraged by our recent positive audit numbers. CFC saw revenue increase by 11.9% in 2022. This marks the seventh year of continued growth and expansion for the company. Part of the revenue increase was due to the \$240 Million in contract wins received by the Federal Contracting Group (FCG) and the significant revenue growth of the Commercial businesses. I am greatly encouraged by the reported revenue numbers for 2022 and the forecast for continued expansion this year.

Much of the company's expansion will be seen with the Commercial Group. In 2023, we will add a new restaurant to our holdings, have the new tram renovations completed, increase our fleet of vans for tourists to travel around town, open a second Village Store location, continue adding business partnerships with Cape Fox Tours and Cape Fox Lodge, and plans are underway to build a new bridge to the George Inlet Cannery. In the first quarter of the year, the Commercial Group has been abuzz with activity as it is preparing for the start of a new tourism season, and the outlook for this season could be historic. According to industry insiders, the city is expecting to welcome an estimated 1.4 million passengers, which is more visitors than pre-Pandemic years. In total, for 2023, the city is expecting 52 ships to dock in their ports. The first ship docked on April 20, 2023, and the season will run through October.

As well as renovation and expansion measures being done this year, CFC is continuing its community engagement initiatives. One of the larger initiatives beginning in 2023, and approved at the Q1 Regular CFC Board of Directors Meeting, will be the implementation of a new dialysis clinic which will be the only dialysis clinic available to patients in southern southeast Alaska. CFC believes strongly that the health and

wellness of our Shareholders are quintessential to the mission of our organization. We strive to find new and increased ways to support our Shareholders, whether it is through financial means, employment opportunities, or innovative approaches to technology and healthcare. The dialysis clinic will enable residents and families of the people of Southeast Alaska to remain in Ketchikan throughout their treatment instead of relocating to other parts of Alaska.

Spring is a wonderful time of year for CFC, and with this year being CFC's 50th anniversary, an extra layer of solemnity is added. CFC's 50 years in business is a significant milestone. The company's legacy was founded on tradition, heritage, innovation, and growth, but its foundation is one of success, hard work, and unity. We must remember the lessons of the past, live and strive for success each day, and keep looking towards the future by creating a path we walk together. CFC's 50th anniversary will celebrate the company, its Shareholders, and its employees as we continue forging a path for greater future success.

Deandra Banie, Matthew Cutler, and Adrianna Oliva-Parks applied for the ATIA Professional Development Scholarship and were awarded a total of \$2,179. CFC is proud of our CFT employees' drive, initiative, and desire to continue to grow their positions and possibilities.

The ATIA Foundation's mission is to assist Alaskans desiring to further their education in the travel industry through programs for students and professional development. The ATIA Foundation offers the Professional Development Scholarship program for Alaskan residents currently employed in a travel industry-related business seeking to advance or build upon their expertise in a visitor industry-related position. Scholarships are given to be applied to registration and materials for continuing education programs such as seminars, we-

binars, conferences, or similar education programs related to employment in Alaska's visitor industry.

The scholarship awards for the CFT staff have already provided many opportunities for each awardee. Deandra Banie, the Assistant Transportation and Logistics Manager, has completed her ServSafe Managers Certification. This certification will allow CFT food and beverage to excel further. Matthew Cutler is the Safety and Training Manager, and Adrianna Oliva-Parks is the Manager of Tour Development and Operations. Both Matthew and Adrianna completed their Entry-Level Driving Training and Commercial Driver's License course for Class B with passenger endorsement.

CFT has stood out for what it offers tourists as it grows and expands each year through

new partnerships and adventure offerings. CFT offers food and beverage options at the George Inlet Cannery and Saxman Community Center. The George Inlet Cannery offers a variety of locally sourced Alaskan appetizers with a variety of locally brewed beverages. Meanwhile, this summer, the Saxman Community Center is transitioning to being the venue for our Alaskan Culinary & Cultural tour paired with a few different operators. Additionally, CFT has been growing its fleet of vans. Last year in operation was a fleet of 33 transit vans, a luggage truck, and then two leased trolleys and three buses from other operators. This year there will be a fleet of 51 vehicles, including eight new motor coaches. With the new certifications received by Matthew and Adrianna, they will be able to drive any vehicles in the fleet and train new employees.

We are proud of the CFT staff who have been enhancing our tour packages and successfully growing their own skills and expertise to stand out further. Great job, Team! ■

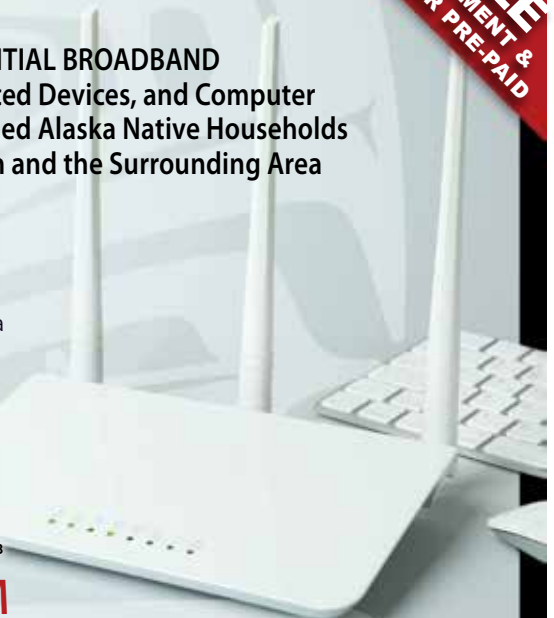

A New Three Bears Alaska Grocery Store Coming Soon to Saxman

In 2021, Cape Fox Corporation (CFC) went before the Saxman City Council to present a deal CFC negotiated with Three Bears Alaska (Three Bears) to bring a grocery store to the south end of the greater Ketchikan Gateway Borough. The proposed grocery store site would be located at the Saxman Seaport. The deal was approved unanimously by the Saxman City Council for Three Bears Alaska to begin building the grocery store at that location.

On March 23, 2023, CFC finalized the deal with Three Bears with a lease signing ceremony. City of Saxman Mayor, Frank Seludo, signed the lease for the deal. CFC Board of Directors President, Clifford Blair, noted in the initial city council presentation that “their vote is the first step of a project but a historic leap toward progress for the City of Saxman.” The grocery store is scheduled to open in mid-May.

Saxman, Alaska, has created an initiative to bring new businesses with the goal of bringing more economic opportunities and rejuvenating the community of Saxman. This new endeavor shows that Saxman is open for business and willing to partner with reputable companies to secure growth and further expand community development. Three Bears is one of those companies. Three Bears is a family-owned chain of Alaskan grocery stores that started their first store in Tok, Alaska, in 1980.

Muriel Strode said, “Do not follow where the path may lead. Go, instead, where there is no path, and leave a trail.” Clifford Blair believes “this is exactly what the Saxman City Council is doing. We are leading Saxman down a road it has never been and blazing the trail!”

This is another historic moment for Saxman and CFC is delighted to be part of this deal by allowing Saxman to move forward commercially and bring greater economic stability to the community. ■

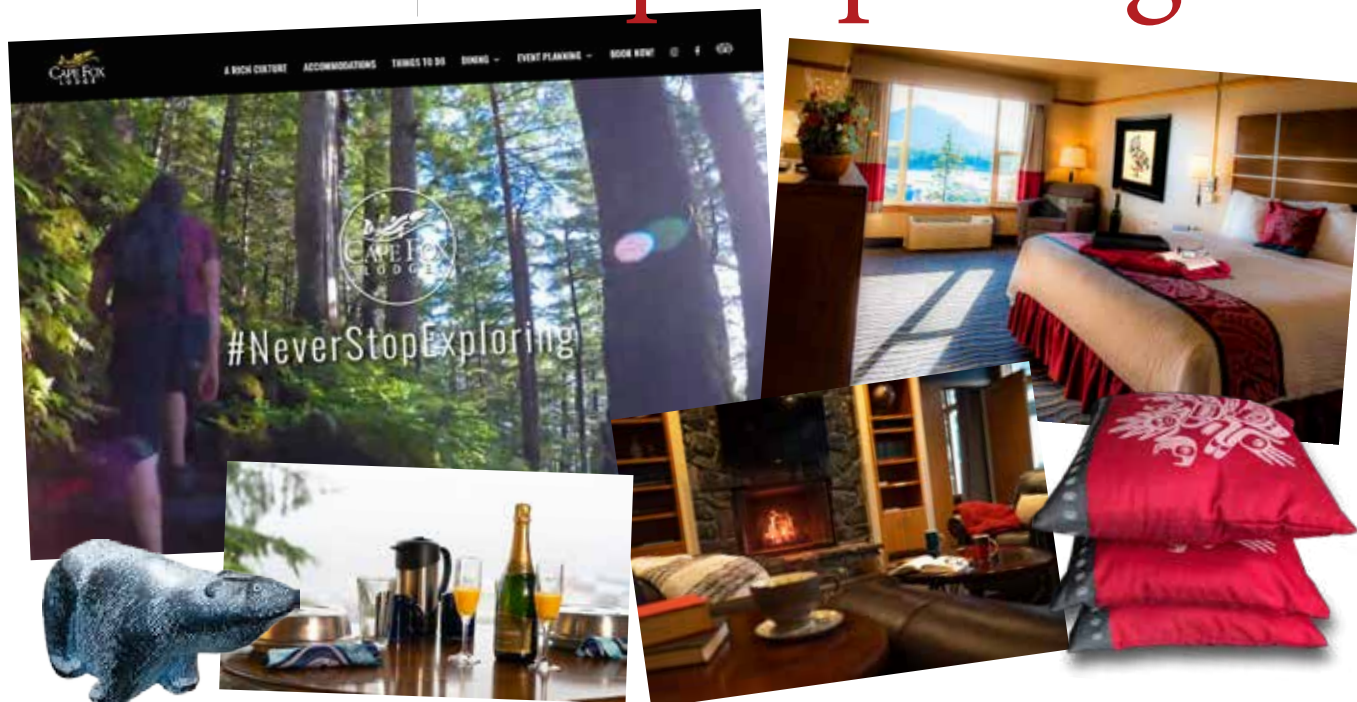

Defense Health Agency

Due to CFFS' graduation from the 8(a) program in December of 2022, we were no longer eligible to receive a follow-on 8(a) award on the Defense Health Agency (DHA) Application Support Services contract. CFFS worked with DHA and teamed with another Alaska Native Corporation 8(a) Prime contractor to put a new contract in

place and prevent a lapse in coverage for the DHA Military Health systems we support. The contract is a base year with two 6-month options. CFFS was able to maintain a 70% workshare on the new contract under the Similarly Situated Entities FAR clause.



National Institute of Health and Infectious Diseases

CFFS employee Christina Johnston was presented with a Tinda Award for her involvement in an electronic property management accountability program that was developed and approved by National Institute of Health and Infectious Diseases. ■
