fifty employees for those seasonal workers who are over 18 and not local. CFC has also ensured that there are several other amenities for our employees including:

- Two shared kitchen and laundry facilities (one on each floor).
- Shared bathroom and shower facilities.
- Two common areas with TV's and couches.
- Each room has between three and six beds, with shelving for each bed.

When young people seek a seasonal job full of travel and adventure at a new location such as Ketchikan, AK, one bia deterrent is housing. CFC has several openings in all of our

commercial businesses, and now we have the means of providing housing for just \$15 per day for those employees who want a great job, a great adventure, and



and I was impressed by the dedication and enthusiasm exhibited by our team.




