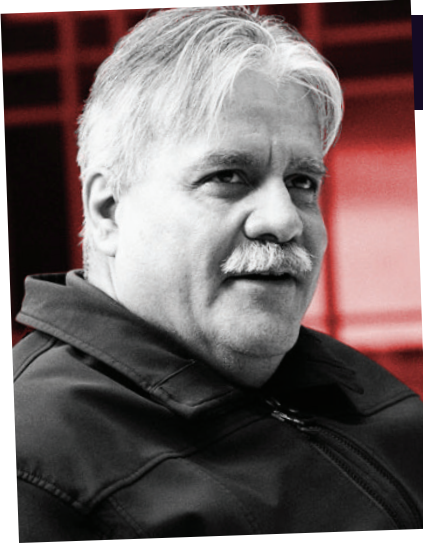

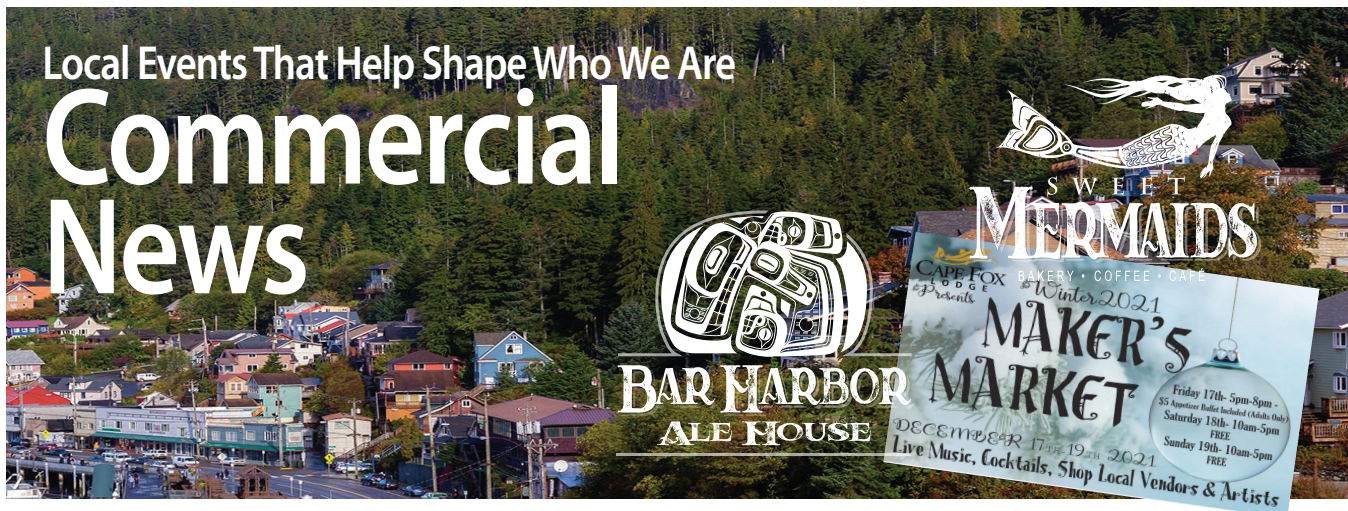

While these new contracts are an important part of the growth and success of Cape Fox, the most important highlight for 2021 is our Program Managers (PMs) and their staff across all our contracts. Our PMs are some of the best in the business, and they work tirelessly to ensure the success of each program.

NAVAR continued to demonstrate post-graduation success in 2021. Successes included:

## Saxman One

Saxman One (SxO) finished its first summer managing advanced internship programs for the Office of Naval Research (ONR). ONR provides opportunities for college students and high school students to participate in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) research at 47 Department of Navy laboratories around the country for 10 weeks. Many of the interns go on to careers with the U.S. Navy. Recruiting for summer 2022 is already underway as SxO works with ONR and the research labs to find the next generation of Naval scientists and engineers.

SxO also just completed the first summer with ONR's Naval Horizons where promising high school and college students are introduced to cutting-edge STEM topics through an online mentorship program. After learning about actual research from Naval researchers, participants enter an essay contest where they imagine the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps of the future. ■
